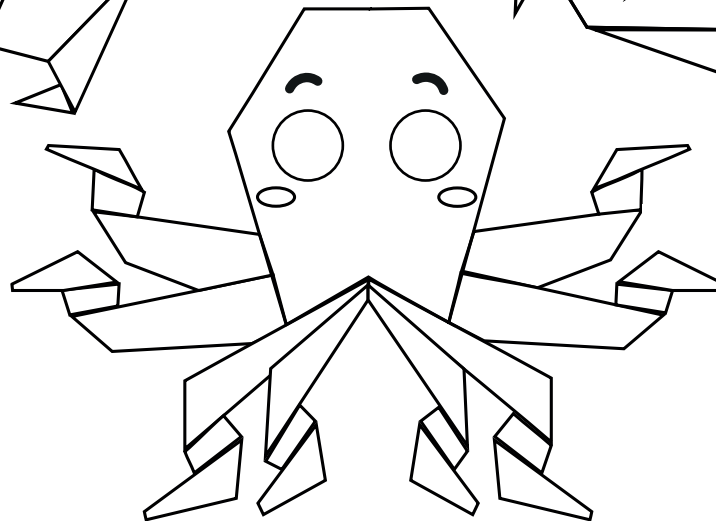
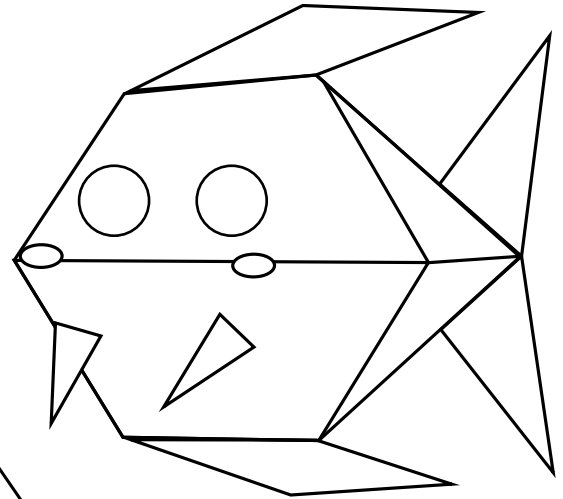
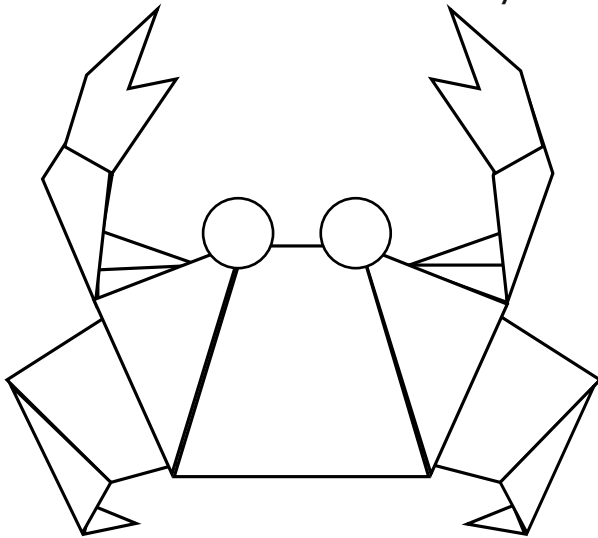




Puppet Making
