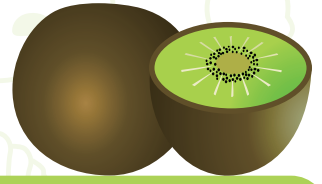

Real-life experience activity – Making kiwi snacks

- Tell children that you want to make kiwi snacks with them today.
- Invite Big Letter K to provide children with some kiwis for making some kiwi snacks.
- Show children a pack of biscuits.
- Invite Big Letter K to teach children how to make some snacks with kiwis and biscuits.
- Invite children to make their own kiwi snack by guiding them to:
 - take a piece of kiwi and a biscuit.
 - dice the kiwi using a plastic knife.
 - put the kiwi on the biscuit.
- Provide children with ample chances to listen to and say the names of the objects: kiwi, kiwi snack.
- Guide children to make association between the letter and the words (e.g., kiwi, kiwi snack).
- Invite Big Letter K to eat the kiwi snacks with children.



Storytelling – Small Letter k Picks Kiwis

Whom should Small Letter k ask for help? Small Letter k thought for a while and said, '**Kangaroo, Kangaroo, can you help me pick some kiwis from the tree?**' Kangaroo said, 'No problem, there are two kiwis.' He picked and put the two kiwis into Small Letter k's bag. Small Letter k thanked Kangaroo and continued to walk.

Small Letter k saw another kiwi tree. He knew he needed help. Sheep, Cow and Kangaroo passed by. Whom should Small Letter k ask for help? Small Letter k thought for a while and said, '**Kangaroo, Kangaroo, can you help me pick some kiwis from the tree?**' Kangaroo picked and put five kiwis into Small Letter k's bag this time.

Small Letter k was happy because his bag was full of kiwis now. Small Letter k said, 'Kangaroo, Kangaroo, thank you so much for your help.'

Extended activities related to the story

- Game: Roll and race
 - Divide children into two teams: one for Big Letter K and one for Small Letter k.
 - Invite one child from each team to move towards a kiwi tree through two paths.
 - Roll a dice (with faces of a big letter K or a small letter k) to see who can move forward: Big Letter K or Small Letter k.
 - Let children who reach the kiwi tree take one kiwi from the tree until all the kiwis are picked from the tree.
 - Count which team has more kiwis.
- Physical activity: Kangaroos jump on the letter K/k
 - Stick the letter K/k and some other learned letters in hula-hoops placed on the floor.
 - Invite children to act as kangaroos by wearing kangaroo headbands.
 - Invite children to take turns jumping into the hula hoops that contain a letter K/k.



Other possible real-life experience activities and extended activities

- Making a letter K/k stick puppet
- Making a kite
 - Ask children to write the letter K/k on a diamond-shaped paper and let children draw on the paper.
 - Guide children to stick some colourful yarns or ribbons on the paper as the tail of the kite.
 - Turn on some music and let children dance with their kites.
- Singing a song
