2.	Programme Partner	Teacup Productions (HK) Limited is a registered charity in Hong Kong. It has organised various English language activities to promote social and cultural harmony and integration in past years, including theatre performances, children's drama workshops, and community radio productions. Teacup Productions has been successfully running English Alliance programmes for lower primary school students since the 2017/18 school year.

Programme Aims and Expected Outcomes	<p>Participants will have an opportunity to –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • understand major sections and dimensions of a short story, • develop English language skills in reading, writing, and speaking, • build and practice vocabulary, comprehension, grammar, and conversation skills, • recognise language patterns, expressions, and their application in real-life context, • present thematic ideas creatively and constructively with confidence, and • participate in STEAM-based story activities. 	
4.	Programme Content	<p>Participants will engage in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • storytelling – listening and reading along a story using dramatic reading from a picture book, • story-based games (e.g., treasure hunt, word bingo and scene building, etc), • story elements and story creation by connecting parts of a story in a logical manner and narrating it, and • story-based STEAM activities 	
5.	Participants	<p><u>Student participants</u> Two groups of P1-2 students (50 students per group) per school.</p> <p><u>Teacher participant(s)</u> 1 to 2 English language teachers as well as 2-4 school teachers of Arts, Maths and Sciences for observing and supporting students' learning.</p>	
6.	No. of Sessions	One 45-minute session per group of students	
7.	Date and Time	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Between 10 October 2023 and 31 May 2024 (Monday to Friday, except public holidays). • Date and time of the workshops will be arranged with successful applicants.
