1.	Programme	Bookworm (Code: TC03P)
2.	Programme Partner	Teacup Productions (HK) Limited is a registered charity in Hong Kong. It has organised various English language activities to promote social and cultural harmony and integration in past years, including theatre performances, children's drama workshops, and community radio productions. Teacup Productions has been successfully running English Alliance programmes for lower primary school students since the 2017/18 school year.
3.	Programme Aims and Expected Outcomes	Participants will have an opportunity to – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> familiarise themselves with key aspects of book making and book writing skills; present and articulate in English by narrating their story concept in class; demonstrate key-stage specific language skills in reading, writing and speaking English words, phrases and sentences; strengthen auditory and visual discrimination through guided lesson activities; and recognise language patterns, expressions and usage by connecting lesson theme with real-life context.
4.	Programme Content	Participants will engage in: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> storybook making - designing & creating a storybook based on a given theme, language-based games (e.g. Talking Bag, Scene It and Alpha-bit, etc.), writing activities and discussion guided by realia, and story-based STEAM activities to enhance comprehension and information application.
5.	Participants	<u>Student participants</u> Two groups of P5-6 students (50 students per group) per school. <u>Teacher participant(s)</u> 1 to 2 English language teachers as well as 2-4 school teachers of Arts, Maths and Sciences for observing and supporting students' learning.
6.	No. of Sessions	One 45-minute session per group of students
7.	Date and Time	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Between 3 October 2024 and 30 May 2025 (Monday to Friday, except public holidays). Date and time of the workshops will be arranged with successful applicants.
8.	Venue	At premises of participating schools.
