4.	<b>Programme Content:</b>	<p>During the <b>3-hour</b> programme, the participants will</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● read the selected poem(s) and monologue(s);</li> <li>● learn the story and characters of selected poem(s) and monologue(s);</li> <li>● listen to recordings of selected poem(s) and monologue(s) read by a professional actor;</li> <li>● read aloud selected poem(s) and monologue(s) to their peers; and</li> <li>● write a simple poem or monologue of their own to share with the class.</li> </ul>
