4.	<b>Programme Content:</b>	<p>During the <b>55-minute</b> programme, the participants will</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● go through a 25-minute pre-task to learn key vocabularies and phrases;</li> <li>● participate in a 30-minute imaginative immersive journey performed by a native speaking cast;</li> <li>● read different text types through interactive reading games and activities; and</li> <li>● express themselves imaginatively/ creatively while interacting with the characters/ cast.</li> </ul>

6.	<b>Participants:</b>	<p><u>Mode A: School Day</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● 40 participants per school: <b>S1 – S2 students</b> and 2 – 3 <b>English Language teachers</b>.</li> </ul> <p><b>OR</b></p> <p><u>Mode B: Saturday</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● 40 participants per school: <b>S1 – S2 students</b>, their family members (aged 6 or above) or teachers.</li> </ul> <p><i>A minimum of 2 teachers or parents <b>MUST</b> accompany the student participants.</i></p>
