

<b>1.</b>	<b>Name of Programme</b>	<b>Rugby English Active Learning</b> <b>(Code: RB01P)</b>
<b>2.</b>	<b>Name of Programme Partner</b>	Hong Kong Rugby Union is a national sports association. It has an exemplary track record in organising both local and international events including the Hong Kong Rugby Sevens.  The Union successfully ran the “Rugby English Active Learning” programme for English Festival 2007 and English Alliance in the 2011/12, 2013/14 – 2018/19 school years. Over 5,500 students participated in the programmes.
<b>3.</b>	<b>Programme Aims and Expected Outcomes</b>	Participants will have an opportunity to – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• have basic understanding of the rules of non-contact TRY Rugby;</li> <li>• execute basic skills of TRY Rugby; and</li> <li>• develop interest in reading stories/information texts on sports in English.</li> </ul>
<b>4.</b>	<b>Programme Content</b>	Participants will – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• read and learn what rugby game is and its core values, e.g. discipline, team work, respect opposition, meaning of win and loss, etc.;</li> <li>• read and learn key rules of rugby game;</li> <li>• play mini rugby games and rugby 7’s games; and</li> <li>• watch a video about rugby game.</li> </ul>
<b>5.</b>	<b>No. of Sessions</b>	<b>Four 1.5-hour sessions</b>
<b>6.</b>	<b>Participants</b>	<u>Student participants</u> <b>20 to 30 P4-6 students per school</b> (All sessions should be attended by the same student participants.)  <u>Teacher participant(s)</u> <b>1 to 2 English language teacher(s) per school</b> for observing and supporting students’ learning
<b>7.</b>	<b>Programme Dates and Time</b>	Between October 2019 and May 2020 (Mondays to Fridays, excluding public holidays)  Class dates and time will be arranged with successful applicants.
