<b>2.</b>	<b>Programme Partner</b>	<p>The Absolutely Fabulous Theatre Connection (AFTEC) is a bilingual Learning Theatre™ and non-profit arts organisation dedicated to nurturing the next generation of youth. <b>3.</b>	<b>Programme Aims and Expected Outcomes</b>	<p>Participants will have an opportunity to –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• learn to appreciate a classic short story;</li> <li>• learn the vocabulary of classic literature and compare them with the English used today; and</li> <li>• engage in critical thinking by following the plot and learning how to deduce and present a theory.</li> </ul>
<b>4.</b>	<b>Programme Content</b>	<p>Participants will –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• read a Sherlock Holmes story by Arthur Conan Doyle;</li> <li>• examine Holmes’ style of detection; and</li> <li>• identify the key story elements and theme as well as learn Holmes’ method of detection and compare it with modern forensic science.</li> </ul>
