1.	Programme	The Unfold Story (Code: CP01P)
2.	Programme Partner	Cyclone Publishing Limited was established in 2002 to oversee the publishing of a monthly magazine, Typhoon Club. The company has developed an extensive database of professionally written and designed magazine features catering for both local primary and secondary school curricula. The company has also successfully run levelled reading activities for English Alliance since the 2015/16 school year.
3.	Programme Aims and Expected Outcomes	Participants will have an opportunity to participate in a variety of specially designed writing, speaking, and listening activities and make their own storybook under the guidance of a native English-speaking tutor.

6.	No. of Sessions	At least two sessions for each class of P4, P5 and P6 in a week
7.	Date, Time and Venue	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each school will be allocated to one week of student sessions. Time of the sessions will be arranged with successful applicants. • All student sessions will be conducted at premises of participating schools or online via Zoom. If the sessions are conducted in face-to-face mode, schools should make an activity room or a classroom available during the week of student sessions.
