Programme Content	Participants will – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • explore a selected theme (“Food and Drinks”, “Festivals”, “Old Hong Kong”, “Environmental Protection”, “Feelings and Emotions” and “Human Relation”) through a variety of drama activities; and • attempt a group writing task followed by presentation and sharing.
