1.	Programme	Experiencing 21st Century English Writing with e-Learning Tools (Code: CU01S)
2.	Programme Partner	The Centre for Language Education and Multiliteracies Research (CLEMR) of the Faculty of Education of The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) was established in 2008 with the mission of operating in different areas associated with English language education. CLEMR has collaborated with over 500 primary and secondary schools in Hong Kong on various projects.

Programme Aims and Expected Outcomes	Participants will have an opportunity to – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • enhance their writing competence through self-regulated writing strategies and e-learning resources/tools; • develop their 21st century skills, including critical thinking skills, collaboration skills and creativity through peer and group activities; • use self-regulated writing strategies and e-learning resources/tools during the before, while and after writing stages; and • enhance their confidence and motivation in English writing.

Programme Content	Participants will – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • read and analyse reading texts of a specific theme; • learn and practice self-regulated writing strategies/graphic organizers in different stages of writing: before, while and after; • engage in learning tasks which develop their self-regulation and 21st century skills, enhanced with e-learning resources/tools; and • create a piece of writing in pairs using Google Docs. Two students from each participating school will be selected to enter the “My Presentation Contest”.

Participants	<u>Briefing Session for Teachers</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At least one English language teacher per school; and • Principals are welcome. <u>Professional Development Workshop on Enhancing Writing Competence through Self-regulation, 21st Century Skills and e-Learning Resources/Tools</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 to 5 English language teachers per school. <u>Student Sessions</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 30 S1/S2 students per school; and • 1 to 2 English language teacher(s) for observing and supporting students’ learning.
