Programme Aims and Expected Outcomes	<p>Participants will have an opportunity to –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • understand major sections and dimensions of a short story; • develop English language skills in reading, writing, and speaking; • develop vocabulary and comprehension skills; and • express and defend their ideas and thoughts creatively with confidence.

Programme Content	<p>Participants will engage in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Storytelling – listening and reading along a story using dramatic reading from a picture book; • Story-based games (e.g. treasure hunt, word bingo and scene building, etc); • Story construction by matching pictures and writing their own story in a logical manner, and narrating it.
5.	Participants	<p><u>Student participants</u> Two groups of P1-3 students (50 students per group) per school.</p> <p><u>Teacher participant(s)</u> 1 to 2 English language teacher(s) per school for observing and supporting students’ learning.</p>
