Programme Content	<p>Participants will engage in:–</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • understanding the relationship between characters and setting of a story; • making a storybook from scratch using simple sentences and dialogues; • narrating their story to their peers and instructor; and • language games (e.g. talking bag, scene it and alpha-bits, etc.).
