Programme Content	<p>Participants will engage in:–</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • making story characters using perforated sheets and reading a story with their constructed story characters using story guides; • grammar games (e.g. mystery bag, build-it-up and magic dice, etc.); and • learning about English grammar and its usage in everyday conversation.
5.	Participants	<p><u>Student participants</u> Two groups of P1-3 students (50 students per group) per school.</p> <p><u>Teacher participant(s)</u> 1 to 2 English language teacher(s) per school for observing and supporting students’ learning.</p>
