1.	<b>Programme</b>	<b>e-Writing with 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills</b> (Code: CU01P)
2.	<b>Programme Partner</b>	The Centre for Language Education and Multiliteracies Research (CLEMR) of the Faculty of Education of The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) was established in 2008 with the mission of operating in different areas associated with English language education. CLEMR has collaborated with over 500 primary and secondary schools in Hong Kong on various projects.
3.	<b>Programme Aims and Expected Outcomes</b>	Participants will have an opportunity to – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• use self-regulated writing strategies and e-learning resources/tools;</li> <li>• develop their writing competence through self-regulated writing strategies and e-Learning resources/tools;</li> <li>• develop their 21<sup>st</sup> century skills, including collaboration skills and creativity through peer and group activities; and</li> <li>• enhance their confidence and motivation in English writing.</li> </ul>
4.	<b>Programme Content</b>	Participants will – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• read and analyse a story or reading texts of a specific theme;</li> <li>• learn and practice self-regulated writing strategies/graphic organizers in different stages of writing: before, while and after;</li> <li>• engage in learning tasks which develop their self-regulation and 21<sup>st</sup> century skills, enhanced with e-learning resources/tools;</li> <li>• participate in Fun and Games activities and do mini reading and writing tasks on iPads;</li> <li>• create their own writing; and</li> <li>• publish their final writing using Book Creator.</li> </ul> Two outstanding pieces of writings from each participating school will be selected to enter the “My e-Writing Contest”.
5.	<b>Participants</b>	<p><b><u>Briefing Session for Teachers</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• At least <b>one English language teacher</b> per school; and</li> <li>• Principals are welcome.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Professional Development Workshop on Enhancing writing competence through self-regulation, 21<sup>st</sup> century skills and e-learning resources/tools</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>1 to 5 English language teachers</b> per school.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Student Sessions</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>30 P4/P5/P6 students</b> per school; and</li> <li>• <b>1 to 2 English language teacher(s)</b> for observing and supporting students’ learning.</li> </ul>
