Participants will have an opportunity to –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • advance understanding of the rationale and principles of innovative, and professional drama and/or public speaking teaching and how this training can contribute to students’ language learning; • plan, design and implement innovative and professional English language lessons with a focus on helping secondary school students use English with greater speaking competence; • supply teachers with ideas to encourage student autonomy and self-confidence in the areas of pronunciation, public speaking, emotional intelligence; • give additional support to teaching professionals to improve students’ incentive and develop students’ public speaking abilities for an academic environment.
