Programme Content	<u>Chamber Debate Club</u> Participants will be put into groups to learn to research and prepare their arguments for the theme based debates on a range of topics concerning real-world issues such as environmental sustainability, future skills, digitalisation and technology. <u>Annual Chamber Debate Event</u> Interested students from each class will proceed to compete in the “Annual Chamber Debate Event”. The event will be livestreamed.
5.	Participants	<u>Student participants</u> 5 S3 to S6 students per school. <u>Teacher participant(s)</u> 1 English language teacher for observing and supporting students’ learning.
