<b>2.</b>	<b>Programme Partner</b>	The HKFYG Institute for Leadership Development Limited, as known as The HKFYG Leadership Institute (“the Institute”), has committed itself to nurturing young leaders for Hong Kong’s future in the past two decades. The Institute specialises in providing structured and diverse training to hone young people’s communication skills, preparing them for personal development and service to the community.
<b>3.</b>	<b>Programme Aims and Expected Outcomes</b>	Participants will have an opportunity to – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• learn facilitation and mediation skills as well as cultivate empathy leadership by engaging multiple perspectives;</li> <li>• practise persuasion and negotiation by building consensus and find common goals among members despite differences; and</li> <li>• develop convergent facilitation, conflict management and collaborative problem solving skills.</li> </ul>
<b>4.</b>	<b>Programme Content</b>	Participants will be put into groups and assigned different roles to work on real-life cases concerning different sectors, private or public alike. In order to foster problem-solving, leadership, communication and collaboration skills in participants, there will be a series of multifaceted activities including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• in-depth research and analysis, which students can engage multiple perspectives and identify a common goal after discussion and negotiation;</li> <li>• field trips, site visits or interviews, which students can engage different stakeholders into conversation, negotiate and communicate ideas, and subsequently reach consensus despite differences;</li> <li>• sharing sessions and post-event evaluation on how they present, negotiate or manage conflicts;</li> <li>• documentation in multi-media format, by which students will showcase their findings, research processes and innovative solutions how they address the issues; and</li> <li>• presentation of final proposal.</li> </ul>
