2.	Name of Programme Partner:	<p>Hong Kong Rugby Union (HKRU) is a national sports association. It has an exemplary track record in organising both local and international events, including Hong Kong Rugby Sevens.</p> <p>HKRU successfully ran the ‘Rugby English Active Learning’ programme for English Festival 2007 and English Alliance in the 2011/12, 2013/14, 2014/15, 2015/16 and 2016/17 school years. Over 3,700 students participated in the programmes.</p>

Programme Aims and Expected Outcomes:	<p>By the end of the programme, the participants will -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● have basic understanding of the rules and regulations of TRY Rugby (non-contact); ● be able to execute basic skills of TRY Rugby; and ● be stimulated to read (develop interest in reading) stories/information texts on sports in English.

Programme Content:	<p>During the 6-hour programme, the participants will -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● read and learn what rugby is and its core values, e.g. discipline, team work, respect opposition, meaning of win and loss etc.; ● read and learn different key rules of rugby; ● play mini rugby games and rugby 7’s games; and ● watch a video about rugby.
