2.	Name of Programme Partner:	Teacup Productions (HK) Limited is a not-for-profit performing arts company. Programme Content:	During the 1-hour programme, the participants will <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● listen to an oral narration of a story using dramatic reading and picture cards to strengthen the listening and comprehension ability; ● be engaged in a story-based treasure-hunt activity with an emphasis on vocabulary building and creative thinking; and ● design an individualised conclusion for the story through writing and selective narration.
5.	No. of Sessions:	Each participating school will be allocated to ONE CLASS which consists of two sessions (60 minutes each) for two different groups of students on one weekday.

English Language teacher(s) per school ● <u>Teacher’s role</u>: to observe the learning process of their students, and supervise and support their learning.
