d. To imagine other people, objects or events that might relate to the picture

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| • I can (play with toys/read books) while waiting to see the doctor. | • I need to take more rest when I get sick. |

| • I feel hot when I have a fever. | • I've got this toy at home. |
| • I feel sad when I get sick. | • I want to be a (doctor/nurse). |
